

The Resident Role in SERV (Safety & Emergency Response Volunteers)

SERV is a resident-run volunteer organization designed to educate residents *prior* to an emergency and works with Willamette View's Campus Safety & Security Department *in the event* of an emergency.

Each floor of every building has several SERV *Safety Liaisons* who are trained to inform residents about appropriate emergency preparation and behavior.

At your SERV introductory meeting you will receive a yellow or red *Get-Out-Of-Bed* bag and a yellow folder with emergency information.

Several times per year you will receive a safety message from your Safety Liaison on specific topics. In addition he or she can answer any questions you may have about safety here at Willamette View.

All residents are expected to follow instructions in an emergency and encouraged to prepare basic emergency supplies.
