TOP PRIORITIES IF RE-ELECTED

Protecting Oregonians — Secured over \$17 million back to workers who had their wages stolen or rights violated. Helped pass bipartisan legislation to protect children by closing a loophole in child labor law.

Expanding Job Training — Strengthened registered apprenticeship programs so everyone can find a good paying job. These programs are funded through existing BOLI revenue and federal partnerships.

Holding Government Accountable — Eliminated bureaucracy and reduced backlogs decades in the making, launched a mediation program for faster results, and helped pass a bipartisan law to make BOLI work better for everyone.

Lowering Costs for Small Businesses — Created a toolkit and advisory council to level the playing field for small businesses, lower their costs, and cut unnecessary red tape.
