Tips For Effective Bulletin Board and Elevator Sleeve Notices

- Know your audience!
 Willamette View residents are from 60 to100 years old with eyesight from good to poor. Do not use Red for text.
 Low Vision readers find it difficult to read.
- Use 18 Pt font size if possible. Use larger font for the title.
- Use maximum contrast between the background and the words in the text. Black on white is best.
 Keep any background color light.
- Use plain lettering like Sans Serif font Calibri with clear enticing images.
- Only use centered lines for the title and the subtitle.
- Tell the reader what to do: mark the calendar, donate money, attend the event. Give day of the week, the date, the name and phone number of the contact person.
- Edit!

Make fewer words count – like poetry. Readers are less likely to get bored, start scanning, or miss critical details. Keep the message short, focused.
